
# **Scattergories Instructions:**

Choose one list from below and print it out, handing one copy to each person (or team) face-down so they cannot see it. Choose a letter of the alphabet and set a 5-minute timer. When the timer starts, each player (or team) flips over their list and has to come up with something in each category that starts with that letter. Only one answer should be written down.

When the timer is up, players put their pencils down and stop writing. Go through each category and share responses. Each player gets a point for a response, UNLESS another player put the same answer, in which case neither player gets a point. You can also give double points for an alliterative answer with two words (i.e., "Peter Pan" if the letter was P and the category was book characters).

At the end, the player/team with the most points wins.
